Ferry company SeaLink's \$50 return fare on their FreightLink vessel (from Kennedy Point) will be in hot demand while Woolworths remains closed following a recent fire on their premises. The company was quick to react, offering a special \$75 same-day return valid Tuesdays, Thursdays and Sundays – on Seacat at 9am and returning at 2pm. "Of course our standard Residents' Deals (offering the greatest flexibility) are another option for grocery shoppers over this time" she said.

SeaLink is also offering a shopper's fare for people without cars. The \$30 fare (\$10 for SuperGold cardholders) pays for a pick-up at Ostend, return ferry and transfers to and from Botany Shopping Centre. This option will be available on Wednesdays and Fridays and must be booked by 4pm the day prior.
