FREIGHTLINK ANNOUNCES NEW SUPER SAVER FARES

FreightLink has announced their summer fares for the service operated by their ferry "Seamaster".

New fares take effect on Thursday 1st October and are no longer based on a tiered pricing structure. The return fare from Waiheke Island will now be \$70 for a car and two people and the fare from Half Moon Bay will be \$100.00 for a car and two people. There are no other restrictions to these fares.

"Our lower fares were extremely popular over the winter months and so we have made the decision to keep our fares low over summer" said general manager Donna Gauci. "At the same time we listened to the feedback from our customers and sales team, regarding the complexity of the tiered structure so have decided to make the fares simpler".

The start of SeaLink's summer timetable with effect from Friday 25th September saw the return of the company's highly popular service to and from Auckland City as well as the re-instatement of the early morning FreightLink service on weekdays, departing from Half Moon Bay at 6am and from Waiheke Island at 7:30am.

With the release of these fares, "We're all ready for a busy summer!" said Mrs Gauci.
